Beautyberry



Hardiness: zone 5-8

Height: 2.5—4 m

Spread: 1.5– 2.5 m

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Flowers: summer

Birds and butterflies are attracted to it.

General Description:

Superb shrub valued for abundant clusters of long-lasting, violet berries covering branches in fall. New growth has bronze tinge. Small, purplish pink flowers appear in summer amongst large green leaves. Deciduous.

Care Notes:

Grow in full sun or partial shade in a well drained soil. The berries are produced on the current season's growth and therefore the plant can be cut back hard annually in spring when the buds start to swell. Grow in full sun or partial shade in a well drained soil.
